Purpose, what do we treat your data for?

For the purposes of the provisions of the RGPD of April 27, 2016, and LO 3/2018, we will process the data we collect for the following purposes:

- Contact you if you ask us to do so.
- Manage your browsing on the web, where appropriate.
- Send you commercial communications about our products and services.

For this, the user will have a registration form whose completion will legitimize the interested party to access and enjoy certain services offered on the web.

However, the user is informed that in any contact form they will be informed of the use that will be made of the data obtained and, if they are used for a different purpose, said consent will be obtained previously and expressly.

If the data subject's consent is given in the context of a written statement that also refers to other matters, the request for consent shall be presented in such a way that it is clearly distinguishable from the other matters, in an intelligible and easily accessible manner and using a clear and simple language, in accordance with article 7.2 of the RGPD of April 27, 2016.



Legitimation, what is the legitimacy for the treatment of your data?

The legal basis for the processing of your data will be based on:

- The consent of the interested party, for the processing of their data, in accordance with article 6. 1. a) of the General European Data Protection Regulation.
- The necessary execution of a contract in which the interested party is a party or for the application of pre-contractual measures at the request of the interested party, in accordance with article 6. 1. b) of the General European Data Protection Regulation.

Recipients Who do we communicate your data to?

Personal data will not be transferred except in compliance with legally established obligations or to support the services linked to this treatment.

Conservation, how long do we keep your data?

We will keep your personal data for at least 5 years in case you are a client and for strict compliance with the legal obligations established in the regulations.

If you are not a client, we will keep your data for the minimum time necessary to manage our relationship.

Rights, what are your rights when you provide us with your data?

Anyone has the right to obtain confirmation as to whether personal data concerning them is being processed.

Interested persons have the right to be able to access their personal data, as well as to request the rectification of inaccurate data or, where appropriate, request its deletion when, among other reasons, the data is no longer necessary for the purposes that were collected.



In certain circumstances, interested persons may request the limitation of the processing of their data, in which case we will only keep them for the exercise or defense of claims.

In certain circumstances and for reasons related to their particular situation, interested persons may object to the processing of their data. In such a case, the data will no longer be processed, except for legitimate reasons or the exercise or defense of possible claims.

Interested persons may request data portability to obtain the data they have provided in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, to be downloaded by themselves or transmitted to another entity.

Minor consent, what happens if you are a minor?

Accuracy, veracity and security of the data, how do we treat your data?

Users guarantee and are responsible, in any case, for the accuracy, validity and authenticity of the personal data provided, and undertake to keep them duly updated. The user agrees to provide complete and correct information in the registration or subscription forms. We will not be responsible for the veracity of the information that is not of its own elaboration and for which another source is indicated, for which reason it does not assume any responsibility for hypothetical damages that may arise from the use of said information.

We will also reserve the right to update, modify or delete the information contained on the website and may even limit or deny access to said information.
